Syon Manor College offers a bespoke, young person-centred approach, integrating extensive clinical therapy. Our small class sizes, individual learning pathways, and structured career progression plans enable students to succeed in employment pathways and independent living.

Our Teaching and Support

Syon Manor's lessons are delivered by specially trained teaching and vocational tutors, supported by our Pastoral Support Assistants and Head of Education and Curriculum. This ensures each learner achieves their best possible outcomes.

We offer a broad and bespoke curriculum consisting of both academic and vocational learning, recognising the importance of community projects and supporting inclusion in mainstream services where applicable.

Every learner is part of our Key Mentor system, ensuring their pastoral, emotional, and social needs are met with a trusted staff member.

Syon Manor College is open **five days a week**.



Qualifications and Partnerships

We work with a range of awarding bodies to offer students recognised qualifications, including:

- **City & Guilds** – Specialist subject qualifications, including access to a two-acre field and farm project.
- **RSL** – Games Design courses.
- **NCFE** – Photography and Art & Design courses.
- **Cambridge** – IGCSE in Accountancy.
- **AQA** – Courses ranging from GCSEs (e.g., Psychology) and A Levels to Unit Award Schemes.
- **Pearson** – Entry Level Certificates, Functional Skills, GCSEs on demand, and BTECs at Levels 1 and 2 (e.g., Hair & Beauty, Business).
- **ASDAN** – Personal Progress, Lifeskills Challenges.

The curriculum is reviewed and adapted each year to meet the needs and interests of our students whenever possible.



Curriculum Pathways

Syon Manor College follows **two main** curriculum pathways:

1. Skills and Vocational Development

Designed for students following vocational qualifications such as ASDAN, Unit Award Schemes, or Entry Level Certificates at Level 1. Students on this pathway are based at either the Vine Campus which also includes our 2-acre horticulture land in Hillingdon or the Aston Campus in Uxbridge.

2. Academic and Career Ready

Designed for students who can engage with core academic subjects such as Functional Skills and GCSEs, alongside vocational courses. Students on this pathway are based at the Isleworth Campus.

We offer a broad and bespoke curriculum consisting of both academic and vocational learning.



Work Experience and Facilities

Syon Manor College is committed to preparing students for the world of work. Our Career Lead follows an employability framework designed to equip all students with the necessary skills and confidence to enter the workforce.

Through structured career planning, work experience placements, and employability skills development, we ensure that every student is well-prepared for life beyond college.

We provide:

- Guidance on career pathways tailored to individual student aspirations.
- Employability workshops covering CV writing, interview techniques, and workplace expectations.
- Work experience opportunities in various industries to build practical skills.
- Engagement with employers to create real-world learning experiences.
- Support with job searching and transition planning to ensure a smooth move into employment or further education.

- All campuses are well-connected with mainline trains, underground stations, and bus routes, supporting students in developing independent travel skills.

Pastoral Support

At Syon Manor College, we prioritise the wellbeing and personal development of our students through a comprehensive pastoral support system. Each student has access to a Key Mentor, providing regular check-ins to ensure they feel supported academically, socially, and emotionally.

Our pastoral provision includes:

- Therapeutic support, including Occupational Therapy, Speech and Language Therapy, psychotherapy and Cognitive Behavioural Therapy.
- Personal, Social, Health and Economic education to build confidence and life skills.
- Work-related learning, such as travel training, work skills sessions, and access to job lists and work experience placements.
- Enrichment opportunities, including clubs and student suggestion boxes to encourage engagement.
- Assemblies and Briefings to provide structure and support throughout the college.
